NAMSAI, Nov 12: Describing Arunachal Pradesh as a gold mine, Arunachal Pradesh Governor Gen (Retd) JJ Singh today once again dwelt on the state's vast tourism and hydropower potential and highlighted the developmental projects being taken up under the Prime Minister's package, says a release

The projects include a bridge over river Lohit and direct connectivity to Tezu under the Trans-Arunachal Highway.

The governor, who inaugurated the Jan Suvidha centre here, assured that a section of the police will be deployed to deal with drugs and narcotics abuse here.
