Scrapping of class X board exam justified A New Delhi report adds: The

HRD Minister today justified the scrapping of the class X board examination, saying the govt was trying to evolve a system where a child's performance is tested in a wholesome manner and not just from books.

'To ascertain the performance of the child, he or she must go through a continuous process, spread the breadth of the horizon of knowledge and move beyond text books," he said here after inaugurating the 19th World Book Fair at the Pragati Maidan here.

The minister was replying to a question posed by his former teacher and historian Irfan Habib that he could not understand why the class X board exam was done away with.
