**BANGLADESH HIGH COMMISSIONER CALLS ON THE GOVERNOR**

**Itanagar Sept. 25:** High Commissioner of Bangladesh to India, His Excellency Mr. Tariq Ahmad Karim called on His Excellency General (Retd) J.J. Singh, Governor, Arunachal Pradesh at Raj Bhavan, Itanagar on 24th September last. He was accompanied by Mr. Md.
