GOVERNOR MEETS ASSOCIATION WELFARE MEMBERS

Representatives of Itanagar Market Welfare Association led by its President Shri Yumlam Achung, General Secretary Shri Biri Basang and four core committee members met on Hon'ble Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Shri P.B. Acharya at Raj Bhavan, Itanagar on 31<sup>st</sup> January 2017.

The members of Itanagar Autorickshaw Welfare Association, led by Shri Dayum Tate and accompanied by Shri Gollo Nikia and Shri Munna Moya Nekam also called on the Governor in the day.
