Deputy Chief Minister calls on the Governor

**Plan in advance for procurement of textbooks for next academic session:
Governor to Deputy Chief Minister**

The Deputy Chief Minister of Arunachal Pradesh Shri Chowna Mein called on the Governor Brig. (Dr.) B.D. Mishra (Retd.) at Raj Bhavan, Itanagar on 3rd September 2018. They discussed on various developmental issues of the State.

The Governor, in pursuance of his oath of the office, i.e. to 'devote himself to the service and welfare of the people of Arunachal Pradesh', emphasized on improving the education sector of the State as his top priority. He stressed on speedy collection and distribution of the textbooks.

The Governor advised the Deputy Chief Minister to plan in advance for procurement of textbooks for next academic session, so that the needy students receive their books at the beginning of their academic session.

While appreciating the Deputy Chief Minister for facilitating in the commencement of the Sainik School by addressing the departmental land issue, the Governor requested him to look into the issue of the State Government's commitments towards the school.
