**Governor participates in the foundation stone laying ceremony by the Prime
Minister**

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, Lt. General KT Parnaik, PVSM, UYSM, YSM (Retd.), took part in the foundation stone laying ceremony led by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi, at Itanagar on 22nd September 2025. The occasion marked the launch of major developmental projects, including the Tato-I Hydroelectric Project (186 MW) and the Heo Hydroelectric Project (240 MW) in Shi-Yomi District, the Integrated State-of-the-Art Convention Centre in Tawang, and 10 other key infrastructure projects worth ₹1,291 crore.
