**Lokayukta Chairman calls on the Governor**

**Governor expresses deep concern over non adherence to procedures and willful violations of existing rules and regulations by departments and individuals**

The Chairman of the State Lokayukta, Justice (Retd.) Prasanta Kumar Deka, called on the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, Lt Gen KT Parnaik, PVSM, UYSM, YSM (Retd.), at Lok Bhavan, Itanagar on 14<sup>th</sup> May 2025.
