Governor meets the Chief of Defence Staff

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, Lt Gen KT Parnaik, PVSM, UYSM, YSM (Retd.), called on the Chief of Defence Staff, General Anil Chauhan, PVSM, UYSM, AVSM, SM, VSM in New Delhi on 18th May 2026. They discussed national security issues with special focus on Arunachal Pradesh, including border security, the Vibrant Village Programme, and the implementation of Goodwill projects in frontier areas.

Drawing from his recent visits to remote border areas of Arunachal Pradesh, the Governor shared his observations on the prevailing security situation and the level of preparedness along the international border. He also expressed concern over the challenges posed by porous stretches along the eastern border and emphasized the importance of strengthening border management and infrastructure.

The Governor appreciated the role of the armed forces in Arunachal Pradesh for maintaining close coordination with the State Government. He said that the strong civil-military partnership has significantly contributed to the development of frontier villages, ensuring that security and progress move forward together.

The Governor also commended the 3 Corps and 4 Corps for their continued efforts in strengthening civil-military relations through regular interactions, community outreach programmes, and goodwill initiatives aimed at supporting the people living in remote border areas.
