Governor reviews law and order situation of the State

Fence construction work be speeded up to ensure extortions and kidnapping incidents can be checked: Governor to DGP

Governor advises DGP to ensure that police personnel remain alert, well-equipped and prepared to undertake search and rescue operations

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, Lt Gen KT Parnaik, PVSM, UYSM, YSM (Retd.), reviewed the law and order situation of the State with the Director General of Police, Dr. S.D. Singh Jamwal, at Lok Bhavan, Itanagar, on 8th August 2026. They discussed the prevailing security environment, crime prevention measures, public safety, disaster preparedness and the overall readiness of the State Police to address emerging challenges.

The Governor stressed that a secure environment is essential for the State's continued socio-economic development and for realizing the vision of a 'Viksit Arunachal'. He shared a 'SURAKSHA APP' which enables real-time security to citizens in cities and recommended that the APP be studied and implemented as convenient.

The Governor discussed the security situation in Tirap-Changlang-Longding region. He directed that the fence construction work be speeded up to ensure extortions and kidnapping incidents can be checked.

The Governor further advised the DGP to ensure that police personnel remain alert, well-equipped and prepared to undertake search and rescue operations during natural disasters such as landslides, flash floods, cloudbursts and other calamities, which frequently affect the hilly terrain of Arunachal Pradesh. He underscored the importance of maintaining quick reaction teams, improving inter-agency coordination with the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF), State Disaster Response Force (SDRF), district administrations and local communities, and conducting regular mock exercises to enhance preparedness.

Deputy Inspector General of Police, Crime Branch, Dr. Joy Tirkey, was also present during the review meeting.
